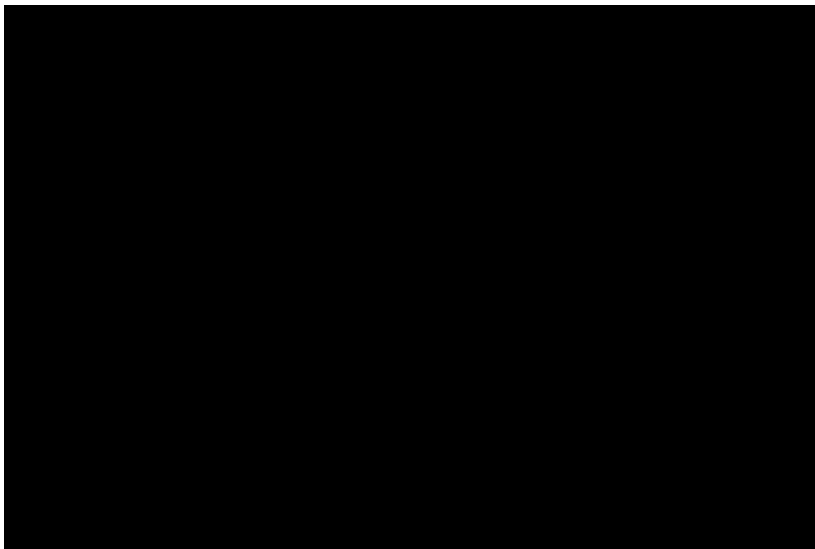
The Lark Bunting is the Colorado state bird.
