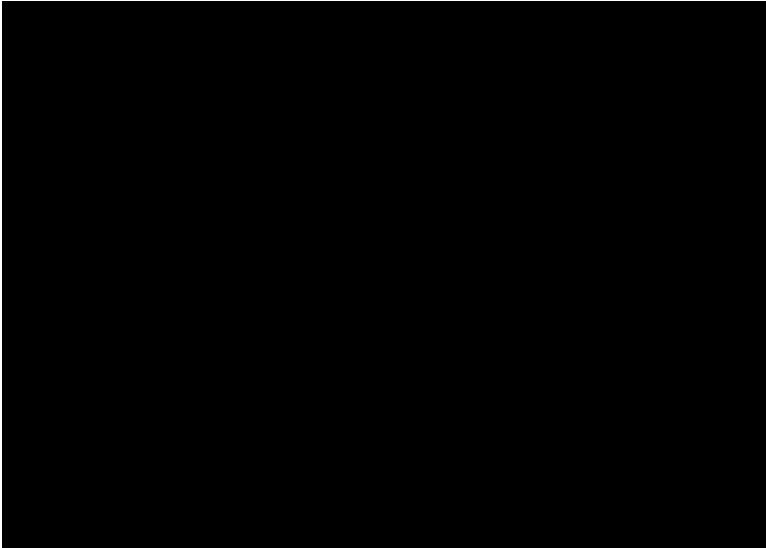
The California Gull is the Utah state bird.
